Planting Calendar

Welcome to the Chickadee Jane garden!

This calendar guide for planting is intended both for newer gardeners and those looking for a planning and tracking tool. Have fun!

Instructions: Determine your desired vegetables and herbs, and the date of last frost in your growing area. For each plant, determine whether you will grow your own seedlings indoors or buy them from a garden centre, and whether you plan to grow a second seasonal crop. Some seeds can be planted directly outside, some have to be started indoors; duplicates on the list below indicate that more than one method is an option. Using your area’s date of last frost, count backward to create a planting schedule by week that will take the guesswork and stress out of your growing season.
